
THE BENEFITS OF MOTION AND CREATIVE PLAY DURING RECESS


Playing or taking a break at recess helps you learn better and remember more.

Spending time outside helps your body and mind (it's one of the **healthiest** things you can do every day).






1 out of 4 adults (and 15% of kids!) in the United States has a disability.

TYPICAL PLAYGROUNDS

Static, One-Note, and Excluding

Standard plastic structures primarily for able-bodied users and one type of play

One-size-fits-some layout with no sensory or imaginative play

Limited movement = low physical activity and engagement

Students return to class unfocused and under-stimulated

No support for inclusion, empathy, or peer development

Minimal community connection, programs, or long-term value
