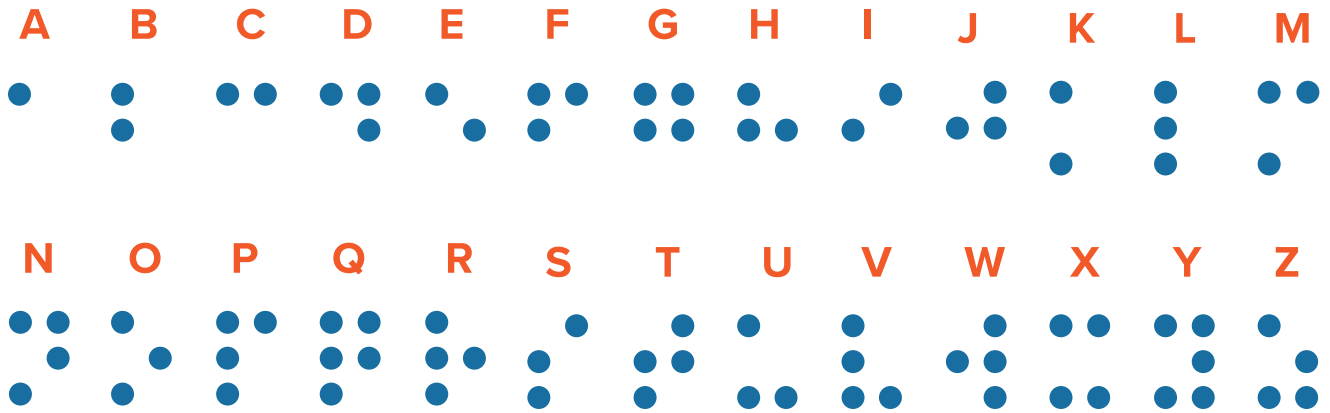


How do people with sensory disabilities communicate?

READING FOR THE BLIND Braille is form of written language for blind people, in which characters are represented by patterns of raised dots that people feel with their fingertips. Below is the Braille dot-pattern alphabet. Can you write your name in Braille?

HEARING FOR THE DEAF American Sign Language (ASL) is a system of communication using visual gestures and signs, as used by deaf people. Below is the ASL alphabet that deaf people use to spell names and things that don't have a gesture established. Can you use your hands to spell your name using the ASL alphabet?
