
## How do people with sensory disabilities communicate?

**READING FOR THE BLIND** Braille is form of written language for blind people, in which characters are represented by patterns of raised dots that people feel with their fingertips. Below is the Braille dot-pattern alphabet. Can you write your name in Braille?

**HEARING FOR THE DEAF** American Sign Language (ASL) is a system of communication using visual gestures and signs, as used by deaf people.
